

1. What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that our website places in your browser or on your computer or Internet-connected device when you visit us online (hereinafter referred to as “Cookies”). This ensures that our website is able to remember your computer or device. The main purpose of our Cookies is to improve your user experience. More information on the use of cookies is available in this Cookie statement (hereinafter referred to as “Cookie statement”).

A “notification banner” will appear on the website asking your permission to place certain cookies. You can accept all Cookies by clicking the “Accept” button. You can also make a selection of the type of Cookies you wish to accept. You can make this selection by indicating your choice in the settings.

2. Information on the use of our Cookies

Our website uses Cookies and similar technologies to distinguish your user preferences from those of other users. This helps us to provide a better experience when you visit our website and also allows us to optimise our website.

However, Cookies and similar technologies do not result in a systematic collection of data. Cookies and similar technologies only help us to improve the operational functioning of our website, to better understand the interests of our users and to measure the effectiveness of the content of our website.

4. Types of Cookies

A. Essential Cookies

These Cookies are strictly necessary for the functioning of the website and cannot be disabled. These cookies do not store any personal data. No permission is required to place essential cookies.

B. Functional Cookies

These Cookies ensure that our website works properly and track how you browse our website. These cookies help to remember your preferences, such as your language preference. No permission is required to place functional cookies.

C. Analytical Cookies

These Cookies ensure that the number of visitors is counted so that we can measure the functioning of our website. These Cookies help us know which pages are visited most.

D. Marketing Cookies

These Cookies track the visit to the website and allow a profile of website visitors to be created. This allows us to optimise our website and display advertisements tailored to your visitor profile.
